




The Annual Community Garage Sale will be Saturday, May 16th from 7am-2pm! If you want to participate, please sign up at the Community Center.



Tapestry is the 4th Wednesday of the month.


Pickleball is played on our multi-sports court. If you would like to get acquainted with the game, sign the interest sheet at the front desk of the Community Center.


Lacey is a Medically Prescribed Service Animal and Therapy Dog. She lives with StoneRidge residents Lisa and Bob Cordaro and has brought many smiles and happiness to local facilities including Mountain Valley Regional Rehabilitation Hospital, Yavapai Regional Medical Center, and recently she accompanied Lisa and Bob to Scottsdale Shea Hospital. She has visited patients in Washington, Oregon, Nevada, California, New Mexico and Mayo Clinic in Minnesota. We decided to share her warm, healing nature as we discovered she is a natural for this work.

With her calm demeanor, gentle disposition, and friendliness to all people Lacey, is an ideal Therapy Dog for patients in all medical facilities. The optimism and happiness a Therapy Dog visit can provide to a patient is one that cannot be measured by a doctor's instruments or recorded on a patient's chart. Some of the therapeutic effects we have witnessed with Lacey's visits are relieving patient stress, lowering blood pressure, and raising mood. We have seen patients, for instance, who have not spoken for extended periods of time begin talking to Lacey (and those around them) in her presence. Just the touch of a patient's hand on Lacey's head has made some patients open their eyes for the first time after a prolonged illness. It is the most rewarding thing to watch.

Having Therapy Dogs in a medical facility helps normalize the setting for children who are away from home under scary and unpleasant circumstances. Elderly people who have not seen their own pets in a long while tell us they are so happy to visit with Lacey. Interestingly, the doctors, staff and parents get as much out of her visits as the patients do.

We are very proud of our Faithful Lacey. She turns six in June. She enjoys her time off and playing in the park here in StoneRidge. She especially loves small dogs, and socializes well with all animals of good nature. Her best StoneRidge canine pal is Nicky Duskey.











Lemon Pie Bars

INGREDIENTS:

2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour


1/2 cup confectioners' sugar

1 cup butter, softened

4 eggs

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Mix 2 cups of flour and confectioner's sugar together. Cut in the butter. Mix well until the dough resembles pie dough consistency. Press the dough into a 9x13 baking pan.
- 3. Bake 15 to 20 minutes or until golden brown.
- 4. Beat together eggs, sugar, 4 T flour, lemon juice and lemon zest for at least 1 minute. Pour the mixture over the baked crust.
- 5. Bake the bars another 20 minutes, or until the lemon topping has set. Sprinkle with confectioner's sugar when cooled.

Life (Lawn & Garden) Style

'It's spring fever. That's what the name of it is. And when you've got it, you want – oh, you don't quite know what it is you do want, but it just fairly makes your heart ache, you want it so!"

Earth Day and Arbor Day are just two days apart this year, so these two holidays often become intertwined. In celebration of Earth Day, which is April 22nd, and Arbor Day, which is April 24th, here are two great ways to celebrate:

Plant a tree. Trees help reduce greenhouse gas emissions, help clean pollution, and help secure soil in place to prevent erosion. Check out the National Arbor Day Foundation's website for some great tips on how you can become involved.

Make a nature craft. Building a birdhouse or bird feeder is a great way to encourage the local bird population. Use objects that would have otherwise been thrown away to create a beautiful and unique work of art. You can even use items like glass stones or mirrors to add a little sparkle in your garden.

Remember, every day can be Earth Day. Anything to help our environment can be a conscious effort on your part. Don't restrict yourself to just one day a year; learn about how you can make a difference to protect your environment. And put it into practice—every day!

What you should be doing in the month of April

- **Home:** Get those windows and screens cleaned! A 50/50 mix of white vinegar (or ammonia) and water makes a great all-natural cleaner for your windows. And to be even greener, wipe your windows with newspaper rather than paper towels. It's amazing to see this actually does the trick! But don't clean windows in direct sunlight; they will streak like nobody's business. A great way to clean your screens is to place them in a kiddy-pool filled with soapy water. Scrub them lightly, rinse with a gentle stream from the garden hose, and lean them against the house to air dry.
- Lawn: Remove sticks, branches, and other debris from your yard. These strong winds can bring all sorts of unwanted debris your way, so make sure to keep up on your spring cleaning all month long.
- **Garden:** Pick a permanent spot in your garden for herbs. Many of these will come up year after year. Parsley is rich in vitamins A and C. Start some seeds indoors now for later transplanting.
- **And...** Put away your tools at the end of the day. It's so easy to leave items lying around your yard at the end of a long day, but make sure to take the time and return them to their proper locations. Clean them and hang them up so they are ready to use and easy to find the next time you need them.


