PLEASE DO NOT FEED THE PIGEONS!

We've seen an increase in the number of pigeons in StoneRidge.

Please remember:

- Pigeons are wild birds capable of finding their own food.
- Feeding pigeons attracts them to areas that are not natural to them.
- Feeding causes excessive breeding, which results in overcrowding. Pigeons can control their own numbers effectively.
- Waste food left for pigeons also attracts other vermin.
- Pigeons carry a range of diseases.
- Pigeon droppings are very acidic and can cause damage to buildings, including tile roofs.
- Large numbers of pigeons can drive smaller birds away.

Notes and Reminders



9-volt batteries power our smoke alarms, household items and toys.
They can be found in most homes.
But these batteries can be a fire hazard if not stored safely or disposed of with care.



- 9-volt batteries can be dangerous. The positive and negative posts are close together. If a metal object touches the two posts of a 9-volt battery, it can cause a short circuit. This can make enough heat to start a fire.
- It is unsafe to store 9-volt batteries in a drawer near paper clips, coins, pens, or other batteries. Do not store common household items such as steel wool, aluminum foil, and keys near 9-volt batteries. If these items touch the two posts, there is a greater risk of a fire starting.
- Weak batteries may have enough charge to cause a fire. Some fires have started in trash when 9-volt batteries were thrown away with other metal items.

Storing 9-volt batteries

- Weep batteries in original packaging until you are ready to use them. If loose, keep the posts covered with masking, duct, or electrical tape. Prevent the posts from coming in contact with metal objects.
- Weep them someplace safe where they won't be tossed around.
-))) Store batteries standing up.
- 9-volt batteries should not be stored loose in a drawer.
 Do not store them in containers with other batteries.

Disposal

- 3) 9-volt batteries should not be thrown away with trash. They can come in contact with other batteries or pieces of metal.
- 9-volt batteries can be taken to a collection site for household hazardous waste.
- To be safe, cover the positive and negative posts with masking, duct, or electrical tape before getting rid of batteries.
- Some states do not allow any type of battery to be disposed of with trash. Check with your city or town for the best way to get rid of batteries.

Monthly Recipe



Yummy Sweet Potato Casserole

Ingredients

- 4 cups sweet potato, cubed
- ♦ 1/2 c white sugar
- 2 eggs, beaten
- ◆ 1/2 t salt
- 4 T butter, softened
- ◆ 1/2 c milk
- ♦ 1/2 t vanilla extract
- ◆ 1/2 c packed brown sugar
- ◆ 1/3 c all-purpose flour
- 3T butter, softened
- ◆ 1/2 c chopped pecans

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Put sweet potatoes in a medium saucepan with water to cover. Cook over medium/high heat until tender; drain and mash.
- In a large bowl, mix together the potatoes, white sugar, eggs, salt, 4T butter, milk & vanilla extract. Mix until smooth. Transfer to a 9x13 inch baking dish.
- In medium bowl, mix the brown sugar and flour. Cut in the 3T butter until the mixture is coarse. Stir in the pecans. Sprinkle the mixture over the sweet potato mixture.
- Bake for 30 minutes, or until the topping is lightly browned.

Seasonal Suggestions for the month of November

Home: If you're looking for some color for the winter, African violets do well when potted in rather small pots. A good general rule is to use a pot one third the diameter of the plant. Encourage African violets to bloom by giving them plenty of light. They can be in a south window during dark winter months.

Lawn: If you haven't already gotten the leaves up off the lawn, get them cleaned up, and keep them cleaned up. Leaves laying on the grass can kill the lawn and leave bare spots for you in the spring. You can keep mowing the lawn every week, even though the grass is not growing, you will be mulching up any fallen leaves.

Garden: Remove all mummified fruit from fruit trees and rake up and destroy those on the ground. Also, rake and dispose of apple and cherry leaves. Good sanitation practices reduce re-infestation of insects and diseases the following season.

And... To keep some life in your yard this season, bring out the bird feeders and stock them with bird seed. Remember to provide fresh water for the little birdies too!


