

Q: I am interested in using the gym in the community center. What hours are the gym open, and are there restrictions on the type of gym attire I wear? **A:** The gym is open and available to residents 24 hours per day. Access to the gym after hours is through the door on the west side of the building, nearest the tennis court. You will need your access card to enter the building. We recommend clothing that is comfortable, and shoes that are appropriate for exercise such as tennis or running shoes. "Lunking" and other displays of aggressive behavior such as dropping weights are not appropriate.



Q: Is there a community mailbox and newspaper stand? **A:** Yes! A post office mailbox and a Daily Courier newsstand are located outside of the Community Center near the parking lot.

Q: I have read that snow is in the forecast. Will the Community Center hours of operation be effected if it snows? A: The safety of the Community Center staff is a high priority. Therefore, if there is an accumulation of snow or ice on the roads, our staff will wait until conditions have cleared before they traverse the roads to work. Generally, if there is a school delay, you may expect the staff to be delayed as well. On snowy or icy days, a phone call to the center before you head over may be a good idea. The phone number is 928-775-7550.

Q: We walk our dogs every morning, and on a few occasions, we have spotted coyotes, a mountain lion and a bob cat or two. Is there a phone number we can call to report the sightings? **A**: Our community is indeed surrounded by wildlife. Take precautions to keep yourself and your pets safe. Visit the Arizona Game and Fish Department at azgfd.com/wildlife to learn about how to safely view and live in the presence of wildlife. If you like, you may report sightings to the Prescott Valley Animal Control at 928-772-9267.

Q: We would like to purchase a new storage shed to keep our gardening equipment in. Do we first need to get approval from the HOA? **A**: Yes. Any addition or modification to the exterior of your home requires Design Review Committee approval. There are sheds available at stores which advertise themselves as "HOA Friendly", however it is better to get approval ahead of time so there is not a problem requiring it to be removed. DRC submittal forms can be found at the community center or on the Stoneridge website at storeridgeazhoa.com under the "Documents" tab. There is no charge for the DRC review, and the committee usually meets on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month.

Winter Recipe

Ingredients

- * 8 large red potatoes
- * 2 tbsp. Extra virgin olive oil
- * $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. salt
- * ¹/₄ tsp. coarsely ground black pepper
- * 1 tbsp. chopped fresh parsley

Directions

- Preheat oven to 450 degrees F. Carefully slice each potato thinly without cutting all the way through.
- * Place potatoes on microwave-safe dish and cover with waxed paper. Cook in microwave on High 12 to 15 minutes or until easily pierced with tip of knife.
- Transfer potatoes to metal baking pan. Carefully drizzle oil between slices. Sprinkle with 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/4 tea-spoon coarsely ground black pepper. Roast in oven 25 minutes or until lightly browned. Transfer potatoes to platter; sprinkle with herbs





Easy Peppermint Fudge



Ingredients

- 2 (10 ounce) packages vanilla baking chips
- * 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- * 1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract
- * 1 1/2 cups crushed candy canes
- * 1 dash red or green food coloring

Directions

- * Line an 8 inch square baking pan with aluminum foil, and grease the foil.
- * Combine the vanilla chips and sweetened condensed milk in a saucepan over medium heat. Stir frequently until almost melted, remove from heat and continue to stir until smooth. When chips are completely melted, stir in the peppermint extract, food coloring, and candy canes.
- * Spread evenly in the bottom of the prepared pan. Chill for 2 hours, then cut into squares.
