HOA DUES.. Your statement is mailed to you one month prior to the due date which the **1st** day of each quarter (January 1st, April 1st, July 1st and October 1st) with the exception of those accounts on autopay who do not receive a paper statement. If your payment is not **received** by the **30th** of the month in which it is due you will be charged late fees. If you are mailing your payment, plan to mail at least 7-10 days ahead of time. If you are on auto pay don't forget to report any changes to your financial institution. You may also drop your payments off at the community center. If you have any questions please come in or call and we would be happy to help! Remember—due on the 1st, late on the 30th!



Exterior Modifications

As outlined in the Stoneridge Governing Documents, any modification to the exterior of your home must first be approved by the Design Review Committee. This includes modifying your landscaping in the front or year yard, painting the exterior of your home, installing patio covers, shades, gazebos, etc. There is an application for submitting your request online or pick one up at the community center. There is no charge to review your modification in most cases. Prior approval will avoid the chance that the modification you make must be removed if it does not comply with the Stoneridge Design Guidelines.




