

#### A Message from your Community Manager

Dear Stoneridge Members,

As many of you know, the Board of Directors has two seats to fill during the upcoming election. Currently, the Founding Members of the Board (who are the developers) hold three seats and the Homeowner Members hold two. Transition is a time where the number of seats change and more Homeowners hold seats and less Founder Members do. This means that rather than the Founder (or developer) maintaining control of the financial and governance aspects of the community, the homeowners will. This transition date is December 31, 2020. It is vitally important that the community be very engaged with this process and be willing to serve on the Board before, during and after transition is complete.

The new deadline to submit a Statement of Interest to run for the Board is on February 6th at 4:00 pm. The deadline had to be extended because only one Statement of Interest was submitted and there are two seats to fill. #### NOTICE: COMMUNITY CENTER REVISED USE POLICY EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1ST, 2019

The Stoneridge Board of Directors approved revisions to the Community Center Use Policy which became effective on January 1st, 2019. Please visit our website and look under the Governing Documents tab to view it or pick up a copy here in the Community Center.

One of the major changes to the policy regards use of the multi-purpose and gathering room. The Community Center facility is designed as a recreational space for the community and not as a space for members to run a business from or to offer classes or services which are available to the public.

The revised policy states only those Members with a valid access card may reserve these spaces on a recurring basis (defined as more than one time per year) only if 75% of the attendees of their class, study group, dance group, etc. live in the Stoneridge community and hold valid access cards. Registered instructors who are certified and carry insurance may continue to offer classes but are required to turn in sign-in sheets after each class showing that 75% of the attendees are Stoneridge residents.

Members that hold an active access card who wish to attend classes, use the gym, pool, fitness studio, tennis court, sports court, reserve the multi-purpose room etc., will be required to scan their card <u>at the door</u> rather than at the counter to gain access to the facility **beginning on March 1st, 2019**. If you bring a guest, you will need to sign them up at the front counter as soon as you enter the building and staff will make sure that we have a current liability release form on file or have them fill one out. Members who allow guests to use the facility or courts without first signing them in at the front desk are subject to losing future access to the facility.

The Board has agreed to give only charitable or non-profit organizations use of the space once per quarter but only if hosted by a Stoneridge Member.

These new policies have been designed to offer greater protection to the members of the community who pay to maintain the facility and minimize the use of the space to others who do not. Thank you for understanding.

Neighborhood Clean-up co-coordinator



Proper American flag etiquette for U.S. citizens includes standing at attention and saluting when the flag passes in a parade or is raised or lowered. The U.S. Flag Code, passed by Congress in 1942, provides guidelines regarding American flag etiquette. It can be access via the USFlag.org website. Those that display the flag should raise and lower the flag as outlined in the code and only if they are committed to following all of the guidelines. Some of these are:

Flags that hang on a wall, door or window should display the Union (the blue section) on the observer's left. Every public institution and schoolhouse should display the flag. People should not display other flags above the United States flag. The United Nations flag cannot be in a superior position to the United States flag, except at the United Nations headquarters.

On a platform, the flag should be above and behind the speaker, with the union to the observer's left. For a church or auditorium, the flag should be on speaker's right as he faces the audience. To cover a casket, the union should be at the head, over the left shoulder.

The flag should never dip to any person or thing. It should only have the union down as a sign of dire distress. It should never touch anything below it, such as the floor, water or ground. If the flag is in poor condition, it should be destroyed in a dignified way.
